# Best Crab Apples

### What is a crab apple?

Crab apples are small-fruited apples. They qualify as a crab apple only if the fruit size is 2" or smaller in diameter.

### Can you eat crab apples?

You can eat crab apples, but you may not like the taste. Most people candy them or use them for making jellies.

### Can I plant the seeds?

They will grow, but you will not get a copy of the parent tree. Crab apple cultivars are grafted to make sure you get the same plant.

### Before you select one...

- Remember that crab apples are in the landscape 52 weeks a year, not just the short time they bloom.
- Plan to visit The Arboretum to see selections in different seasons; summer for foliage color and density; fall for fruit color and size; winter for form and fruit retention.
- Crab apples grow best in full sun. Soil should be moist but well-drained. Provide plenty of room for the mature height and spread.

### The selection process:

There are 1,129 crab apples on the grounds including 264 in the Crab Apple Collection. One hundred and thirty individual taxa are represented including 18 different species and hybrids, and 112 different cultivars (figures based on 2000 statistics). Of these, the Horticulture staff has picked 23 outstanding crab apples worthy of consideration in central Ohio landscapes.

### Why were they selected?

These particular cultivars have good flower, fruit and form; have shown resistance to blight, rust, scab and canker diseases; do well in this climate on these soils; and are available in the nursery trade.

### How can you acquire these trees?

Mark the names of the trees you like and take this brochure to a nursery so they can get the exact same plant for you. Be cautious of substitutes.
